- Parental concerns regarding bullying: physical/social and at school events:
 - School administration should be notified if bullying occurs or with bullying concerns
 - Mrs. Perry explained her position on cell phone policy and social media concerns with bullying:
 - No phones during school day
 - Sometimes it is a child being mean and not necessarily bullying
 - Seek assistance from a guidance counselor
 - Get in touch with parents and try to help student through situation
 - Monthly character assemblies at school
 - 2 boys assaulted and robbed at high school before the middle school / high school teacher basketball game
 - Parents concerned no though given to security during time after the school day and before the event began; upset/frustrated no call was sent out about the incident; parents did get police involved; parent also spoke to Sue Truesdell

- Some parents at PTSA meeting expressed that the more information we have about incidences the better; encourage parents to follow same policy as if it is an event like a basketball game here at school – where student must go home and return when game starts; have more community conversation about keeping our children safe; should it be addressed at a higher level; suggested to reach out to Julie Hen
