 - Cost \$100 million
 - There will be some redistricting
 - Building an addition onto Pinegrove Middle
 - Adding additional Pupil Personnel to check residency
- High School Capacity Study
 - Possible 3 or 4 new high schools built in Baltimore County or additions made to existing schools
 - All plans on the BCPS website
